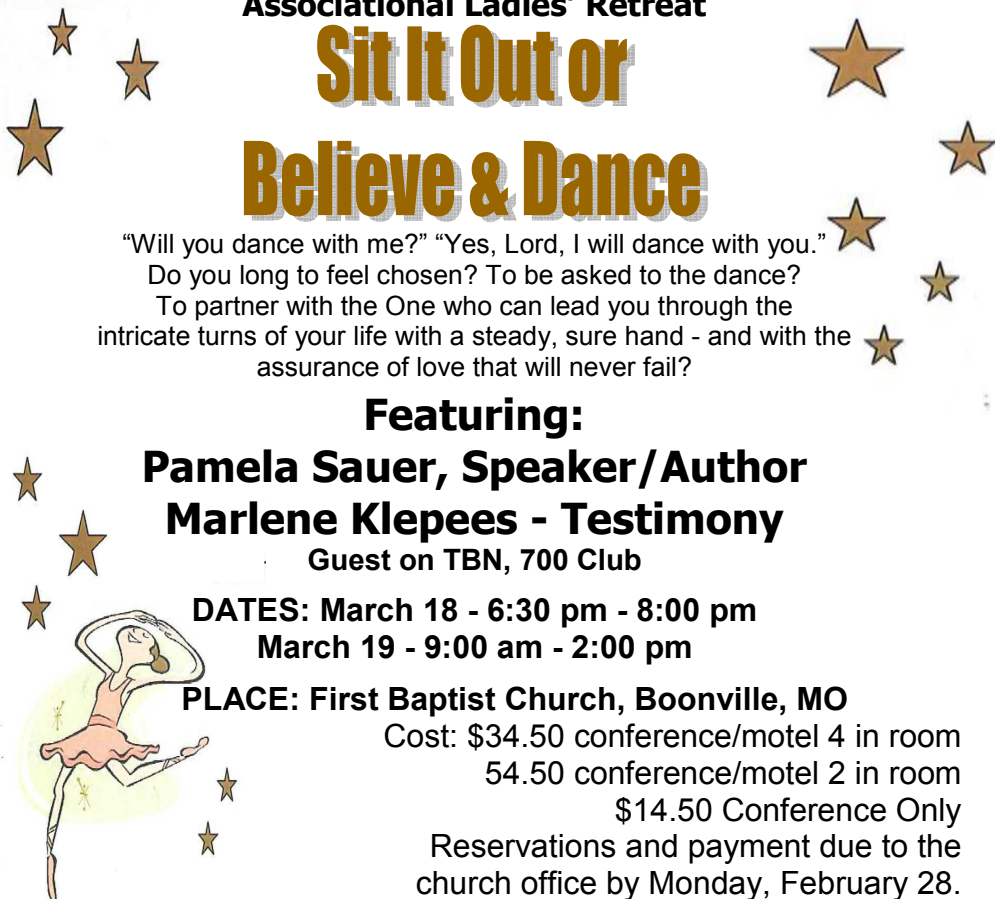

Treasurer's Report was presented as printed. Treasurer Wayne Stackhouse made a motion to approve. 2d by Evelyn Watson. Note: Lottie Moon Offering exceeded \$1970. Motion carried.

Mary Pace reported for the **Outreach Committee** that a project to **distribute Bibles** to at least 100 families in the neighborhood by February 14 was being planned. 80 English language and 20 Spanish language Bibles have been ordered. Retail price \$9.99 each; our cost, \$3.99.

Scott Braun invited the entire church to meet at his home to view the Chief's game on January 9. On January 19, there will be a parents' meeting to evaluate the past year, plan for future mission trips. **Valentine's banquet** tentatively scheduled for February 12. We will participate in **3MT**; more churches are needed; we hope to have about 100 youth participants. A host church should provide a project which will put 10 students to work, along with adult sponsors. Date for 3MT is July 10-16. Next planning meeting will be March 14.

John Stowe, Sunday School Director, reported that Edna Palmer has agreed to sponsor **the 4th Sunday breakfast**.

Rev. Marlin Brown will preach January 9 and conduct the **Lord's Supper Service**.
