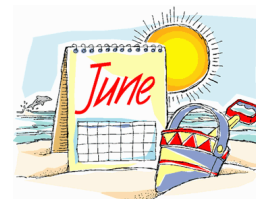

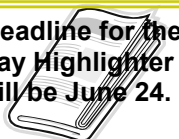
Pastor's Corner

(2) **Pastor Search Committee**: Becky Carver, Elizabeth Lane, Cole McMullin, Don McMullin, John Stowe. All Biblically grounded, compatible, representing a cross section of the congregation. All were approved.

Rev. Bartlett stated that the church should direct the Committee as to whether to consider a bi-vocational pastor; must seek God's man. Don McMullin, as Chairman of Deacons, will see that all information is brought to the church before any action is taken.

It was announced that there will be no evening service on **Mother's Day**.

Scott Braun stated that he will be on vacation May 9-15. His duties are covered. Graduate recognition will be May 22; he needs names and pictures of graduates. June 1 will be a lock-in for Youth & College. 3MT will be July 10-16. Cost: \$100 each participant. Drama team from SW Baptist University will perform.
