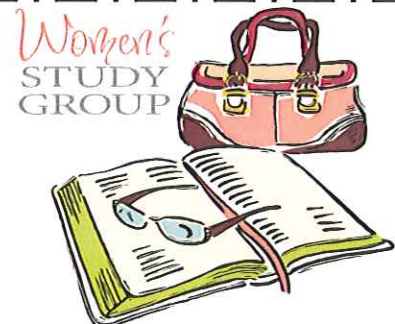

FOUNDATION FOR LIFE

Holy: Set Apart for a Purpose

(Leviticus 20:26)



“And you shall be holy to Me, for I the Lord am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.”

Adrian Rodgers once said, “God is not interested so much in making you happy and healthy as He is in making you holy.”

To live “holy” means to be “set apart,” living in some ways different than the world. The Bible says in Romans 12:2, “And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God” which is your holy separation to Him.

The children of Israel were to be “set apart” in their lifestyle, in their worship, and in how they related to others. Recall as many of the Ten Commandments as you can and consider which ones relate to lifestyle? Worship? Treatment of others? In what ways would others observe a “set apart” difference in your lifestyle? Worship? Relationships with others? (See Exodus 20.)

As Christ-followers, certain decisions, choices, and commitments set you apart, but what’s the purpose? Because we worship on Sunday or are careful not to lie, are these choices simply to make us weird or different or to become sources of pride? I don’t think so! Absolutely NOT! The children of Israel and we, as followers of Jesus, are to be set apart from certain things in this world in order that we would be set apart to a deepening relationship with the Lord.

Notice in this passage the purpose statements “be holy to ME” and “separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.” Thus, we worship on Sunday not out of duty or obligation, but out of a longing to meet together in deepened intimacy and worship of Jesus. Now that’s the point. To live a holy life includes being set apart from certain things of this world to enjoy the richness of relating intimately with Christ. Holiness is not primarily about what we “can’t do” or “don’t do” - it’s about what we “get to do” in pursuing Jesus.

To live a holy life is not to be unplugged, if you please, from the world but to be plugged into God’s agenda in the world. It’s not a disconnected life, but a very connect life - connected to Jesus.

Now that’s a foundation to build on.
